As a player he quickly gained a reputation for fight, determination and ability. Originally introduced as a junior and at 19 was elevated to the top side where he remained until family life relocated him to the central coast.

His statistics stark and overwhelmingly impressive:

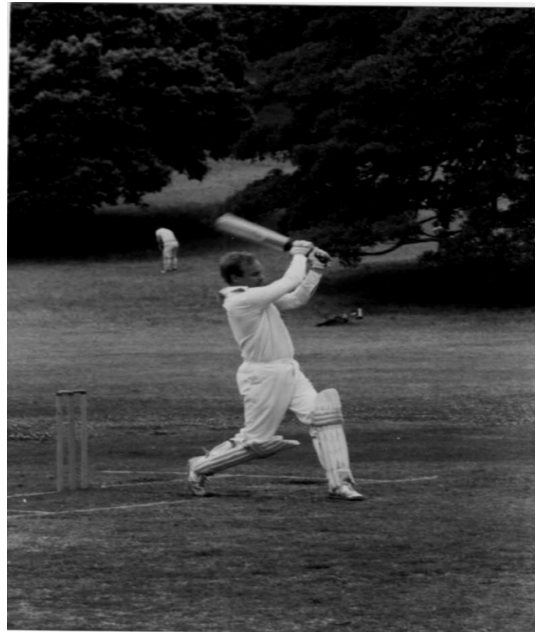
- 8,109 runs, all but a handful not in the top side.
- Average 28.96
- Highest score 116
- Centuries, 4 all in first grade.
- Innings 283 and games, just short of 300.
- He also held the 1st wicket record of 221 set in 1984/85 with Tony Murphy.

He captained the top side for many seasons, his greatest disappointment that he never achieved a premiership, and the final we lost in 1984/85.

An opening batsman by choice he will be remembered by his hallmark legside play. In the 15 seasons that I had the pleasure of playing with him there would be but a few cover drives, and somehow the opposition never quiet picked it up. The average supports the story.

A tough and often uncompromising competitor he never wore a thigh pad or gave in.

Off the field, same outstanding qualities. He was honoured with life membership in 1994 after many years serving the club. As committeeman, treasurer and sometimes groundsman. His commitment always present, at one stage there was a ritual where local juveniles took great pleasure on Friday nights attacking the Longueville wicket. A select committee of three was established, he led the charge literally, sleeping at the oval one such night 'The committee' were awakened by the intruders. The culprits quickly apprehended and delivered to the Lane Cove Police Station.



During the 2017/18 season he wished to return to his club and spend some time watching the 1st, this was done. He met some of the players and opposition supporters, many of whom he played against.

TREASURER'S REPORT 2018/2019

The 2018/19 season was a strong season for the Lane Cove Cricket Club, with a return to profit.

Whilst there had been challenges with growth in Senior players in the past, there was a noticeable increase in Senior subscriptions, which was of benefit to the club in a year where junior members subscriptions have plateaued. While the number of junior teams continues to be strong, our financial security is dependent on maintaining this into future years.

For the year ended 30 April 2019 the Club returned a net profit of \$. This profit is also improved by the fact that we are holding larger stocks of player clothing which will be utilised in the 2019 year. I note that while operational expenses continue to rise over time, appropriate measures have resulted in maintaining an acceptable level of expenditure, however, continued focus is critical.

Ground Hire and increased NSJCA fees continue to be the club's largest expense, and any material increase in these will result in financial pressure on the club that may see the increase of player subscriptions.

Significant consideration will need to be given to the level of player subscriptions in 2019, which may result in a fee increase to ensure the clubs viability.

It's pleasing to see newcomers to the Club and the sport of Cricket and the Club needs to ensure that a lot of time and effort is invested into the future of the Club, being the junior teams.

I would like to thank our sponsors and supporters for their continued support in the sport of cricket, and the Lane Cove Cricket Club.

The Club continues to maintain its financial position and we are well positioned for growth. As a Club, we have access to the best training and playing facilities in the broader Sydney community. I would like to thank all those involved from captains, junior representatives, coaches, players, parents and generally anyone who has continued to carry on the fine traditions of the Lane Cove Cricket Club.

Notes to the financial statements
30 April 2019

Note 1. Significant accounting policies

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the years presented, unless otherwise stated.

New, revised or amending Accounting Standards and Interpretations adopted

The incorporated association has adopted all of the new, revised or amending Accounting Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ('AASB') that are mandatory for the current reporting period.

Any new, revised or amending Accounting Standards or Interpretations that are not yet mandatory have not been early adopted.

Basis of preparation

In the officers' opinion, the incorporated association is not a reporting entity because there are no users dependent on general purpose financial statements.

These are special purpose financial statements that have been prepared for the purposes of complying with the New South Wales legislation the Associations Incorporation Act 2009, the Charitable Fundraising Act 1991 and associated regulations. The officers have determined that the accounting policies adopted are appropriate to meet the needs of the members of the Lane Cove Cricket Club Inc.

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement requirements specified by the Australian Accounting Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ('AASB') and the disclosure requirements of AASB 101 'Presentation of Financial Statements', AASB 107 'Statement of Cash Flows', AASB 108 'Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors', AASB 1031 'Materiality', AASB 1048 'Interpretation of Standards' and AASB 1054 'Australian Additional Disclosures', as appropriate for not-for-profit oriented entities.

Revenue recognition

Revenue is recognised when it is probable that the economic benefit will flow to the incorporated association and the revenue can be reliably measured. Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable.

Sales revenue

Events, fundraising and raffles are recognised when received or receivable.

Donations

Donations are recognised at the time the pledge is made.

Grants

Grants are recognised at their fair value where there is a reasonable assurance that the grant will be received and all attached conditions will be complied with.

Interest

Interest revenue is recognised as interest accrues using the effective interest method. This is a method of calculating the amortised cost of a financial asset and allocating the interest income over the relevant period using the effective interest rate, which is the rate that exactly discounts estimated future cash receipts through the expected life of the financial asset to the net carrying amount of the financial asset.

Other revenue

Other revenue is recognised when it is received or when the right to receive payment is established.

Income tax

As the incorporated association is a charitable institution in terms of subsection 50-5 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997, as amended, it is exempt from paying income tax.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Current and non-current classification

Assets and liabilities are presented in the statement of financial position based on current and non-current classification.

An asset is current when: it is expected to be realised or intended to be sold or consumed in normal operating cycle; it is held primarily for the purpose of trading; it is expected to be realised within twelve months after the reporting period; or the asset is cash or cash equivalent unless restricted from being exchanged or used to settle a liability for at least twelve months after the reporting period. All other assets are classified as non-current.

A liability is current when: it is expected to be settled in normal operating cycle; it is held primarily for the purpose of trading; it is due to be settled within twelve months after the reporting period; or there is no unconditional right to defer the settlement of the liability for at least twelve months after the reporting period. All other liabilities are classified as non-current.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are always classified as non-current.

Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents includes cash on hand, deposits held at call with financial institutions, other short-term, highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value.

Trade and other receivables

Other receivables are recognised at amortised cost, less any provision for impairment.

Property, plant and equipment

Plant and equipment is stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items.

Depreciation is calculated on a straight-line basis to write off the net cost of each item of property, plant and equipment (excluding land) over their expected useful lives as follows:

Buildings	40 years
Freehold improvements	15 years
Plant and equipment	3-7 years
Motor vehicles	5-7 years
Office equipment	3-5 years

The residual values, useful lives and depreciation methods are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at each reporting date.

An item of property, plant and equipment is derecognised upon disposal or when there is no future economic benefit to the incorporated association. Gains and losses between the carrying amount and the disposal proceeds are taken to profit or loss.

Impairment of non-financial assets

Non-financial assets are reviewed for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate that the carrying amount may not be recoverable. An impairment loss is recognised for the amount by which the asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount.

Recoverable amount is the higher of an asset's fair value less costs of disposal and value-in-use. The value-in-use is the present value of the estimated future cash flows relating to the asset using a pre-tax discount rate specific to the asset or cash-generating unit to which the asset belongs. Assets that do not have independent cash flows are grouped together to form a cash-generating unit.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Trade and other payables

These amounts represent liabilities for goods and services provided to the incorporated association prior to the end of the financial year and which are unpaid. Due to their short-term nature they are measured at amortised cost and are not discounted. The amounts are unsecured and are usually paid within 30 days of recognition.

Fair value measurement

When an asset or liability, financial or non-financial, is measured at fair value for recognition or disclosure purposes, the fair value is based on the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date; and assumes that the transaction will take place either: in the principle market; or in the absence of a principal market, in the most advantageous market.

Fair value is measured using the assumptions that market participants would use when pricing the asset or liability, assuming they act in their economic best interest. For non-financial assets, the fair value measurement is based on its highest and best use. Valuation techniques that are appropriate in the circumstances and for which sufficient data are available to measure fair value, are used, maximising the use of relevant observable inputs and minimising the use of unobservable inputs.

**Independent auditor's report to the members of The Lane Cove Cricket Club Inc.
Report on the financial report**

I have audited the accompanying financial report, being a special purpose financial report, of the Lane Cove Cricket Club Inc., which comprises the statement of financial position as at 30 April 2019, the statement of profit or loss for the year then ended, notes comprising a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information, and the officers' assertion statement.

Officers' responsibility for the financial report

The officers of the Lane Cove Cricket Inc. are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report, and have determined that the basis of preparation described in Note 1, is appropriate to meet the requirements of the Act and is appropriate to meet the needs of the members. The officers' responsibility also includes such internal control as the officers determine is necessary to enable the preparation and fair presentation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the financial report based on our audit. We have conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Those standards require that we comply with relevant ethical requirements relating to audit engagements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial report is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial report. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the association's preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the association's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the officers, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial report.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Opinion

In my opinion, the financial report gives a true and fair view of the financial position of the Lane Cove Cricket Club Inc. as at 30 April 2019, and its financial performance for the year then ended.

Basis of accounting

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to Note 1 to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial report has been prepared to assist the Lane Cove Cricket Club Inc. to meet the requirements of the Act. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose

SENIOR CLUB REPORTS

First Grade Report:

We entered season 2018/19 with a lot of promise after falling one win short of the Grand Final last year. We were able to keep the same group of players together, with our overseas player Zen Malik being replaced by promising young talent Freddie Boys.

We knew that the one big area for improvement was scoring more runs, and we started the season off well on that front, scoring 240 against Lindfield but were denied the opportunity for 6 points due to wet weather in week 2.

After a disappointing result against Mounties at home after being sent in on a wet Tantallon wicket, we headed into round 3 against Roseville needing a win to stay in touch with the top 6.

Roseville batted well to post a big score of 9/305 declared, and after a good start of 0/56 we limped to 8/195 and looked to be staring down the barrel of another disappointing loss. Joe Scarcella joined me at the crease and we knew that there was an opportunity to do something special. Fast forward an hour or so and we completed a remarkable win with two wickets to spare, Joey making a lightning fast 65* to complement my 110* at the other end. A 111-run partnership which equalled the club's record for the 9th wicket.

We were hoping that would kickstart our season, but a frustrating loss against Auburn meant that we were languishing outside the top 6 heading into a crucial game against Epping. We went from 1/0 to 1/166 with Freddie Boys (102) and myself (87) putting on a big partnership, eventually being bowled out for 281. Despite dominating Epping, we fell one wicket short of getting the 6 points and had to settle for a draw.

We followed that effort up with a poor batting display against Warringah, and our season hit rock bottom in a dreadful effort against Mac Uni which is a game probably best never spoken of again.

At the halfway point of the season it was all but over, and to rub salt into the wound we also lost Freddie to a broken finger. On the plus side, we had the best bowler in the competition Liam O'Hare to come back after gallivanting across Europe, coming back into the side for the second half of the year.



We needed to be almost perfect after Christmas, and we started off with a close win against Balmain Souths, and a sensational win against Burwood where Joe Scarcella (5/36) stepped up as stand in skipper and combined with Slug (3/32) to rip through Burwood and defend our modest total of 131 by 10 runs.

A crazy game at Strathfield ended with the Covies finishing agonisingly 1 wicket short of a win, which was the second time this season we settled for a draw with the opposition 9 wickets down.

Despite winning the final two games against Penno and NWS, the draws ultimately caused our demise and we fell just short of finals.

Onwards and upwards to next season!

Fourth Grade Report:

A lot can be said about the 2018/2019 Lane Cove 4th Grade season. On paper, it was not a wonderful year. 1 win from 13 games. Not a stellar year in anyone's book. But you need to look past the results to see where the success lied for the 4th grade team. Even though success is normally measured with wins versus losses, there were a lot of positives that must be taken from the year. These positives are the building blocks that future success, and ultimately wins, will be made from and must be recognised now that we have come to the end of yet another wonderful Covie year. The term "a rebuilding phase" is often written off as a cliché, however, in the case of Lane Cove 4th Grade, the statement can be considered more than apt. Despite being in a "rebuilding phase" for some time, some real progress was made this year in a number of areas. Junior progression, player consistency, competitiveness, and training participation were all highlights this year and something that we are looking to build on for next year.

One of the key focuses this year for the 4th grade team was to create easier pathways from the junior club into seniors cricket. We have taken some great steps forward in this respect and a significant factor in this has been the work put in by Damian Barbelier in particular. By introducing a number of juniors to the senior teams and assisting in many of them being selected for 4s and Tim Creer Cup, we now have a clear pathway for these talented juniors to take the next step in their cricketing lives and make the transition to the senior teams. I cannot thank Damian enough for the assistance that he was this year, from simply having the 16/17s train with the senior teams to making them available for selection to finding juniors to fill in at short notice for the senior teams, his efforts we appreciated immensely.

A number of these juniors provided some of the greatest highlights of the season as well. We do not have to look too far into the season to see the impact the juniors made on the 4th grade side. In the first round of the season we got a glimpse of what might be to come with two fantastic contributions from junior players. Firstly, despite not being a Lane Cove junior, the bowling effort of 13 year old Dylan Ranjan to take 6/66 from 14 overs all while Lindfield were belting us around KSO was more than impressive. For such a young Leggie to have the composure and skill to land leg spin consistently while much older men were dispatching bowlers around the park shows what sort of talent these kids have.

Along with Dylan's effort, the only other highlight of being a game that turned out to be a draw was the batting of 17 year old Carson Forrest. Carson had his first year in the senior club this year after playing all the way through the junior club. Despite being picked to open the bowling and bat 11, as Fat Skip thought he was medium pace bowler, Carson's efforts opening the batting and bowling Leg Spin (yes Fat Skip got that one wrong) started what would be an impressive season for Carson. A Slick looking 40 would lay the platform for the player that would ultimately be the leading run scorer for the 4s this year. Despite having a very lean run with the bat after Christmas, Carson's efforts with the bat, bowl and in the field had a major impacting on the fortunes of the 4s this year and while still having some aspects to work on, Carson shows a lot of promise to become a very solid cricketer in higher grades in the years to come.

Another highlight provided by the juniors this year was in our one and only win for the season against eventual Grand Finalists Strathfield. After rolling Strathfield for 117, lead by the returning Cameron Bezer with 5 wickets and Harry Shaw with a 4, the Covies were confident to knock off the runs to get the first points of the season. At 6 for 80 it was in the balance when young Ethan Mudalier-Bek walked to the crease to replace Brendon Hood who had to take a break from the hot humid conditions. Ethan batted beautifully to guild us to the winning runs. The most impressive that he showed was not his technique however, it was his mindset. For a 15 year old kid, playing in his first Shires game against a seasoned older outfit, who don't mind a chat, showed a mentality well beyond his years. While he may only have scored 26, he faced well over 100 rocks, something not many of the senior guys could do all season, to put us in a position to get the biscuits. Despite taking 21 overs on day 2 to make the 17 runs required, Ethan lead us to a great victory and once again showed the talent that we have coming through the club that will prove to be the mainstay of the club in general in the years to come.

Despite only winning 1 game this year there were also a number of other major highlights throughout the year. I have listed a number of them below

- Mark Schaafsma's 53 from 198 rocks against Roseville. Schaafs batted for over 60 overs in an innings that saw the 4s bat through an entire day for the first time in my memory. Despite proclaiming that he needed a new bat

as he could not get it off the square and even while having his hands cramp up, Schaafs showed tremendous composure and fight to lay a platform for the rest of us to bat around. Unfortunately, we could not get the win after having them 8/150 chasing our 200, drop catches costing us dearly.

- The Return of Cameron Bezer. After a few years in the wilderness, Bezer returned to the Covies and proved that despite being a few yards slower in pace, he can still get the job done. Two 5 wicket hauls including a 7/35 from a 20 over spell against Pennant Hills, contributed to him running away with the 4th grade bowling award.
- The First ever Ranjan/Ranjan Wicket. As above young 13 year old Dylan Ranjan came to the club with immediate effect, however, after a number of months cajoling, Dylan's father, Darpan, was convinced to come out of retirement to play some cricket with his son. To see the excitement on the older Ranjan's face when he managed to take a stumping off his sons bowling reminded us all of our love of the game.
- The club getting around our win against Strathfield. It is not very often that we get a win in 4s and it is not very often that our games go longer than the other grades so it was great to see all the other grades get down to KSO to cheer us on while we batted out the day to be able to sing the song for the first and last time this year. Even though some of the guys had to have the lyrics printed out for them it was the great to see the club come together as we know it always does.

Lastly there is just a few people I would like to mention and thank for the assistance that have provided throughout the year. As above, if it was not for the help of Damian Barbeler, fielded many of the teams that we did this year, been as competitive as we were or seen the development of the juniors through the grades.

As always Brendon Hood for always being around to help out whenever needed. From pulling the covers off early doors so we can get a start, helping get players, organising clean ups, supplies and the things you need to get on the park and even playing some cricket this year, Hoody was always there when needed. Putting 4th grade on the park each week would not have been possible with the assistance of Dave Fagan in getting the teams together. So many times, when we had someone pull out on a Friday night, to have a replacement by the next morning was unbelievable. Despite stealing my spot at first slip, I could not have done it without him.

Throughout the year, despite being stolen by 3rd grade a few times, Marc Fini has always been a great assistance and vice-captain. From stepping up to skipper when I could not play, making suggestions in the field and helping wrangle the heard of cats that 4s sometimes is, Fini's impact on 4s and the club is inspiring, however, I will beat him in the Fat Race next year....



There is many more that I cannot name but thank you all that have played or contributed to 4s this year and I look forward to a bigger and better 2019/20.

LCCC Junior Cricket Committee Report 18-19

There were a number of milestones and changes in the club and Junior Cricket nationally which made for a very busy and active year for LCCC Junior Cricket. This season saw numbers increase slightly from in the vicinity of 320 to 351 memberships. The big increase was in girls cricket. For the first time in the club's history we fielded dedicated girl's teams. By season end we had 3 x teams in the NSCJA U11 Girl's Stage One comp. The new CA junior formats continue to be rolled out after many big changes previous season. Various tweaks and changes had to do with things like ball weight and pitch length for various ages kicking in. Our committee's membership is currently healthy with 14-odd members and with only a couple of spaces to fill in the coming season.

The Junior Committee nominated this season as having a "skills focus" and for this reason we enacted a policy of making sure that teams were run with fewer numbers rather than greater. This was so that we could ensure as many kids had the longest game time possible. While this meant that some teams had to scratch around for players when absences occurred, we were very happy with the general result that all kids got a decent hit and bowl in our teams. We are hoping and anticipating that this will have benefits in the future in terms of increased skill levels, more retention of players and ultimately more games won.

We made the decision not to offer the CA "Master Blaster" program to U8 players. Instead we put all our U8 players into a 2nd division of U9s. This was very successful and reports are that the kids had a create time and developed well in this more competitive environment. This was similar to other clubs in the NSJCA who had the same concerns as we did about that program. These concerns are mostly centred around the by product of these CA programs that it delays and hinders the kids progress as cricketers compared to the 2nd division U9 comp where they can play proper games. The CA program also hinders our ability to identify and train up volunteers and also it dilutes the children's concept of their association with LCCC as their home club, a loyalty that means we easily loose kids to other sports as a result. We see all these factors as directly threatening the clubs future. We propose to not offer the CA program in 2019-20 also. The younger Junior Blaster program was offered, but this only because in reality we run it in its entirety and CA have really nothing to do with it. All that happens there is that CA takes a cut of the membership fee which is not ideal but we have decided to accommodate this for the sake of compliance to CA.



A big problem last year was our U17 teams who did not have official training and who were not managed sufficiently well. This year we put in place a range of new measures to help retain U17 players and continue their growth and skills. We had them train with the Seniors at Riverview turf nets, we had a selection committee and they were trained in a planned way by my self as U17 coach where I concentrated specifically on tailored programs for each player's needs. It was a great season with the boys enjoying each other's company and playing at a high standard. The ultimate plan here is to retain members as they transition into the Seniors and I believe we went a long way towards achieving that goal.

As mentioned we had great success with our first ever dedicated girl's teams. The culture and positivity around this development was instilled by the efforts of some specific dedicated volunteers in the club, namely John O'Farrell, David Micheletti, Damian Barbeler and Brendan Hood all of whom put in extra effort to make sure that the experience for our new female recruits was positive and enriching. The girls had an excellent time and we had a great retention rate across the season so that the girl's number increased and LCCC also won both the Spring and Summer competitions, with all our teams dominating the ladders.

We had excellent success in competition terms with our U10 teams also. 2 x U10 teams contested a Grand Final this year. Our other age groups were very competitive with only the slim numbers having the occasional damping effect on our talent pool in each team. Our U15 Slater Team once again got to the Grand Final but Sadly this year did not go all the way. They can however be proud of the achievements they have attained year on year in that team.

An area of concern is our U15 representation for next season. This is a problem across the NSCJA and low numbers in this case probably stem from competition changes that occurred when that cohort was in U12 that meant many left to play other sports. I have been discussing the issue with Mat Rogers who has agreed to help generate some interest for next season to try to get a team up and running.

A big administration task this season was to adopt and enact the new Cricket Australia child protection policy. This was a large change at the club as it required a large number of parents to take up a volunteer Working with Children check from the state government. Thanks must go to Paul Hinton who was largely responsible for running our compliance on this issue. There are a few loose ends to chase in 2019-20 but we at least have a majority of our volunteers compliant at this point in time.

This year for the first time LCCC ran a training day event for coaches and managers. We were fortunate to have Ash Doolan, 1st Grade Cricketer and professional coach as a guest to teach our volunteers. It was a very successful morning and many reported how helpful and productive the event was.
